Terms and Conditions/Guidelines Regarding the MA in Governance and Development Programme (MAGD)

- 1. This is a residential programme and students have to reside in the BRAC University Savar Campus in twin shared rooms and also their food and lodging will be covered under the programme. Breakfast (08:00AM-09:15AM), morning tea (11:00AM-11:30AM), lunch (01:00PM-02:00PM), evening tea (5:00PM-05:30PM) and dinner (08:00PM-09:00PM). The timing will have to be strictly adhered to. The menu will be selected by the authority of residence, Savar. It will not be possible to entertain requests except religious grounds.
- 2. MAGD students must maintain at least 80 percent attendance in individual courses (both credit and non-credit courses), otherwise they will not be allowed to sit for final exams of those courses. Up to five leave of absence applications may be entertained during the course of the whole programme only on special grounds, and such applications have to be approved by the programme authority. Generally Fridays and Saturdays are considered weekend time, but occasionally some classes may be scheduled for special reasons during this period (e.g. make up sessions and guest lecturers). No transport facility will be provided to the students except for emergencies (e.g. sickness and injury).
- 3. Individual computer will be provided to the students. Only Ms Office, Acrobat Reader, Internet Brower, SPSS will be available in their computers. The students will be using the computers through the user account and they are not able to access the administrator's account. Wifi facility will be available in residence, Savar. The students will also enjoy access to online literature resources notably JSTOR and BRAC University's Library through the MAGD internet.
- 4. Each student will receive BDT 7,000 a month as 'pocket money'.
- 5. Each student will receive BDT 10,000 as a thesis grant.
- 6. Any guest of the MAGD students is strictly forbidden to enter the residence, Savar.
- 7. MAGD students have to abide by BRAC University's Student Conduct Rules 2008 at all times.
- 8. Foreign students will be provided a return air ticket for participating in the MAGD programme.
- MAGD students have to complete their dissertations before the end of the third (final) semester of the course.
- 10. MAGD students will be taken on a foreign study tour during the Third semester of the programme to one or more countries selected by BIGD. The foreign study tour's duration will be more than one week. During the tour, students will be given a per diem according to BIGD's standard policy. The students will have to bear hotel, food and local transportation charges from their per diem.
- 11. MAGD Students are required to strictly adhere to and be governed by the rules, regulations and policies of BRAC University in all matters relating to the academics, residence, food and lodging, student conduct, all forms for harassment, local and foreign travel, etc.

12. It is not advisable to interact and socialise with the BRAC University's under graduate students except authorized game.

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
