







Charter of Establishment and Management of D-8 Technology Transfer and Exchange Network (D-8 TTEN)

Preamble:

Considering the objectives and special capacities of the D-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation enshrined in its charter, one of the most important steps towards achieving the position explained in the D-8 2030 strategic document is to pave the ground for developing technological cooperation between member states.

Recalling the meeting of the D-8 senior officials in the second meeting of industry ministers on October 5, 2011, in Istanbul, Turkey, the D-8 technology transfer and exchange network proposal called D-8 Technology Transfer and Exchange Network (D-8 TTEN) was introduced by I.R. Iran's Pardis Technology Park.

Bearing in mind that the plan to establish a network in the working group on technological cooperation was approved by the countries and finally, the D-8 TTEN has been launched in the meeting of the Ministers held on October 9-10, 2012 in Dhaka, Bangladesh as an affiliated body of the D-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation.

D-8 TTEN is an information and exchange network between member states, which is responsible for creating the convergence and synergy between the D-8 member states through capacity building and informing about the achievements and needs of technology and organizing technology exchanges.

Paving the ground requires the creation of a structure for establishing interaction and sharing cooperation and information contexts concerning the supply and demand of technology and technological products, and ultimately the creation of synergy among all active factors in these fields among D-8 members.



1. Introduction

D-8 Innovation Co-Fund Initiative is a multilateral cooperative funding platform amongst its members of relevant national organizations of D-8 member countries and other relevant guest countries aiming to


- share the national science, technology & industrial policies, and research activities in the member countries and create joint collaborations for benefit of member states;
- II) mobilize multi-national and transdisciplinary collaborative STI actions;
- III) strengthen the interactions of the enterprise research and development impacts;
- IV) and, facilitate mutual investment opportunities for joint SMEs in multi-national innovation ecosystems

2. Scope of Cooperation

The cooperation includes joint funding of transnational cooperative research, development and innovation projects. The joint funding is organized based on national/regional funding programs with both joint evaluation and investment procedure. The cooperation also applies to any related activities between members, especially promotion of the initiative and the co-organization of rotating partnering events.


